FIRE TEAM LEADER / EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

COURSE AIM

To provide participants with training and knowledge to competently muster and control a fire team and to assist outside agencies in emergency situations.

COURSE CONTENT

On completion of this activity, participants will be able to demonstrate a competence in the theory and practice of the following:

- Training techniques
- Leadership training
- Rating of bulkheads and windows
- Fire control and extinguishment
- Hazardous material response
- Fire scenarios
- Foam
- Fixed fire fighting systems
- Equipment maintenance
- Flammable liquid fires
- Self contained breathing apparatus (SCBA)
- Multi deck Search & rescue (SAR)
- Ship terminology
- Emergency management

COMPETENCY

Participants are required to pass an assessment of practical skills and a written or verbal examination of theory.

PRE REQUISITES

Medical clearance and completed a Basic Fire Fighting Course.

COURSE DURATION

This course is conducted over four (4) days in conjunction with the Fire Team Member Course.

METHOD OF TRAINING

Fire ground or similar approved complex in which to conduct:

- Theory training
- Practical extinguishing of fires
- Confined space area for breathing apparatus exercises including rescue techniques
- Confined space for foam filled environment
