STCW 95 FIRE PREVENTION AND FIRE FIGHTING

COURSE AIM

The purpose of this module is to provide the emergency response team members, with the knowledge and skills to work safely and competently when responding to emergency incidents involving fire.

COURSE CONTENT

On completion of this activity, participants will be able to demonstrate a competence in the theory and practice of the following:

- Combustion process
- Extinguishment for each class of fire
- Personal protective clothing
- Detection and suppression systems
- Benefits of safety inspections and maintenance training
- Fire behaviour
- Portable extinguishers
- Operation of fire fighting equipment
- Fire suppression strategies and tactics

COMPETENCY

Participants are required to pass an assessment of practical skills and a written or verbal examination of theory.

PRE REQUISITE

Seafarers are required to be medically fit as per Regulation 1/9 of STCW95.

COURSE DURATION

This course is conducted over two (2) days.

METHOD OF TRAINING

Classroom theory sessions followed by practical periods, conducted at a Fire Training Establishment.
