# (502) - MAJOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (OFFSHORE) 4 day

## COURSE AIM

This course is designed to introduce offshore operators to the philosophy and underpinning knowledge behind Major Emergency Management on an offshore facility.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES

To train personnel through theory, simulation and practical demonstration in the techniques of Major Emergency Management.

To review and test company procedures related to Emergency Response.

To identify any areas of deficiency in Emergency Response (site specific)

## COMPETENCY

All participants will be assessed on performance and understanding and will receive a certificate of attendance.

## PRE REQUISITE

No specific pre-requisites exist for this course although it is preferable that attendees have worked as part of the Emergency Management Team

## COURSE DURATION

The course is designed to be conducted over a four day period however this may vary on availability of personnel and course numbers.

## METHOD OF TRAINING

Participants will be required to attend theory sessions and demonstrate knowledge and understanding through practical training sessions onboard the facility.

Participants will also be observed using SEATAG's emergency management simulator, throughout the training syllabus participants will be encouraged to contribute in feedback and debrief sessions.
