601 – OFFSHORE SAFETY & SURVIVAL

Tropical - Basic Offshore Safety Induction & Emergency Training (B.O.S.I.E.T)

COURSE AIM

This course is intended to meet the minimum standards of proficiency in the personal safety and social responsibilities, personal survival techniques, elementary first aid, fire prevention and fire fighting training requirements of the International Maritime Organization (IMO) as per Resolution A.891 (21) Recommendations on Training of Personnel on Mobile Offshore Units . The course also incorporates SEATAG's Helicopter Safety and Escape Training (HUET) course.

COURSE CONTENT

By the end of the three-day program, participants will have an understanding and a thorough knowledge of the following:

- Introduction to offshore safety management systems.
- Actions to take in emergencies
- Living and working offshore
- Correct use of various personal Life Saving Apparatus
- Deployment of life rings and associated equipment
- Modes of Evacuation
- Lifeboat procedures
- Boarding life rafts or buoyant apparatus
- Safely Entering Water From Height
- Water Survival skills and techniques
- Survivor rescue techniques including climbing scramble nets and helicopter winching
- Basic Fire Fighting theory
- Practical uses of fire extinguishers, hose reels and fire blankets
- Theory plus practical escape through smoke, heat and darkness
- Basic Life Support - DRABC
- Expired Air Resuscitation and Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation.
- Bleeding control and shock management
- Hazards of Helicopter Over water Operations
- Safe helicopter operations - Pre ditching drills
- Surface abandonment and Underwater Escape drills

COMPETENCY

Participants are required to pass an assessment of practical skills and a written or verbal examination of theory.
