CHEMICAL SAFETY

COURSE AIMS

To be able to identify, store and handle chemicals in the workplace.
To understand and comply with chemical handling regulations and procedures.

COURSE CONTENT

- Interpret and use data available on plant chemicals.
- Identify chemical hazards, controls and recovery procedures.
- Understanding of storage requirements including methods, containers, and segregation.

- Acquire understanding of chemical handling regulations and procedures including transportation, spill contingency, decontamination, and disposal.
